ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

1. Females having domicile of Punjab are eligible for admission.
2. The candidates must have passed M.S./MPhil with minimum CGPA 3.00 out of 4.00 (Under Semester System) or 1st Division (Under Annual System) in MS/MPhil/ or equivalent degree from HEC recognized institution.
3. The candidates must have secured minimum 60% marks in the subject GRE conducted by DAS of GCWUF.
4. Candidates working in the Government/Semi Government or private institutions shall have to submit "No Objection Certificate" from the concerned organization, failing which their admission shall stand cancelled.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

1. Females having domicile of Punjab are eligible for admission.
2. The candidates shall be eligible to apply for admission, who have at least 45% marks in terminal degree.
3. Admission will be granted strictly on merit i.e. on the marks obtained in FA/F.Sc./I.Com/ICS or equivalent examinations for morning programs only. However, candidates of the earlier sessions will be considered by deducting 10 marks for each year for evening programs only.
4. Maximum age limit is 22 years on the last date of receipt of applications. Age relaxation may be granted in special cases by the Competent Authority up to 4 years.
5. * Eligibility Criteria is as per mentioned in the university prospectus.
6. An aptitude test will be conducted for BS Fine Arts (BFA).

GRADUATE PROGRAMMES

MA/MSc (Morning & Evening)

Applied Psychology, Arabic, Botany, Business Administration (MBA Executive, 2 years), Chemistry, Commerce, Computer Science, Economics, Education, English, IT, Islamic Studies, Mathematics, Physics, *Public Administration, Sociology, Urdu, Zoology

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

1. Females having domicile of Punjab are eligible for admission.
2. The candidates shall be eligible to apply for admission, who have at least 45% marks in terminal degree. At least 45% marks should be obtained in the major subject in which admission is being sought (where applicable).
3. The candidates who have passed BA or equivalent examination in 2016 and 2015 will be considered for admission in morning programmes. In case of evening programmes, the candidates of earlier sessions will be considered by deducting 10 marks for each year.
4. Maximum age limit is 26 years on the last date of receipt of applications. Age relaxation may be granted in special cases by the Competent Authority up to 4 years.
6. * Eligibility Criteria is as per mentioned in the University prospectus.
7. An aptitude test will be conducted for MA English and MA Islamic Studies.

POST GRADUATE PROGRAMMES

MS/MPhil (Evening)

Arabic, Botany, Chemistry, Food Science & Technology, Home Economics (Food & Nutrition), Islamic Studies, Urdu, Zoology

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

1. Females having domicile of Punjab are eligible for admission.
2. The candidates must have passed MA/MSc or BS 4-years or equivalent degree in the relevant field from HEC recognized institution with at least 50% marks (Under Annual System) or 2.50 CGPA (Under Semester System) for admission to MS/MPhil Programmes.
3. The candidate must have secured minimum 50% or more marks in the subject GRE conducted by DAS of GCWUF
4. Merit will be calculated on the basis of the percentage of the Marks of the terminal degree converted into 800.
5. Candidates working in the Government/Semi Government or private institutions shall have to submit "No Objection Certificate" from the concerned organization, failing which their admission shall stand cancelled.
